Psalm Response

'Seek God, you who are poor, and your hearts will revive'.

Pope Leo XIV, unity and communion.

It is hard to believe that Pope Leo has been Bishop of Rome for two months. By meeting world leaders, presiding over important liturgies and speaking words of justice, our wonderful new Pope has thrown himself in at the very deepest of deep ends. None of us can imagine how he is feeling. Good on him for having a holiday at Castel Gandolfo.

I think Pope Leo's motto is a précis of the papal ministry. In taking "in illo uno unum" (in the one [Christ] we are one), Pope Leo indicates that unity and communion, are for him, a priority and a way of being Church. Indeed, the Pope has described unity and communion as his "way of acting and thinking".

True 'horizontal communion' (communion between human beings) arises out of God's relationship with us, which we can call 'vertical communion'. Horizontal communion does not amount to much unless it is fed by God's relationship with us. God's peace is the "peace the world cannot give". So, we are one, not in each other, not in our human communities, not in our particular agenda or ideology, nor in our sense of feeling entitled to be right, but in Christ. The Church has been torn by dis-unity ever since she was mystically founded by Jesus. You could say, that backstabbing and agenda-based thinking have been trademarks of Christians throughout the ages. Though the Church is divinely founded, she has sinful human members. This mean we are always in a state of perpetual injury and recovery. The last few years have brought about no exception to this pattern.

So, Pope Leo has a duty to preside in love over the Church. May God guide him, so that he may be a man of true communion, grounded in God, not in himself.
