Seeking the Divine Presence

In the quiet moments of our week, many of us feel a deep yearning for something more. We sense a calling to invite more of God into our daily routines, our families, and our hearts. Seeking more of God is not about adding more tasks to our busy schedules. Instead, it is about shifting our awareness to His constant presence and allowing His grace to reshape how we live and interact with the world around us.
